Agreement Terms:

Ownership:

• The dog will reside with the guardian, but the breeder retains full ownership and stud rights until the end of the dog's breeding career, at which point ownership will be transferred to the guardian.

Stud Rights and Responsibilities:

- The breeder has the right to use the dog for stud purposes a specified number of times, as agreed upon in this contract.
